→ PATHWAY 1

INDEPENDENT PRACTICE REGISTRATION



**You're
eligible if:**

- ✓ You hold a full, unrestricted U.S. license
- ✓ You completed accredited U.S. postgraduate training
- ✓ You're board certified in your specialty
- ✓ You meet language proficiency requirements



**Practice independently
upon approval**



**No supervision
required**





→ **PATHWAY 2**

SUPERVISED PRACTICE REGISTRATION

If you don't meet full independent criteria, you can begin work under supervision.



**You're
eligible if:**

- ✓ You hold a U.S. MD/DO
- ✓ You have a license in good standing
- ✓ You meet clinical competency requirements

and earning**

**Pathway to independent
licensure in 6–12 months**



WHAT YOU'LL NEED TO APPLY

- **CV / Medical Resume**

- **Proof of U.S. license and good standing**

- **Medical school transcripts**

- **Residency training verification**

- **Board certification or exam records**

- **Proof of English language proficiency**

- **Reference letters**

- **Regulatory history reports**

→ AT A GLANCE

APPLICATION TIMELINE



Month 1–2:

- Review eligibility
- Collect documentation
- Prepare and submit application



Month 3–4:

- CPSO Application Reviewer
- Interview or Assessment (if required)



Month 5–6:

- License Issued (supervised or independent)
- Begin work at clinic with full support

Note: Timelines may vary depending on case complexity and document readiness.

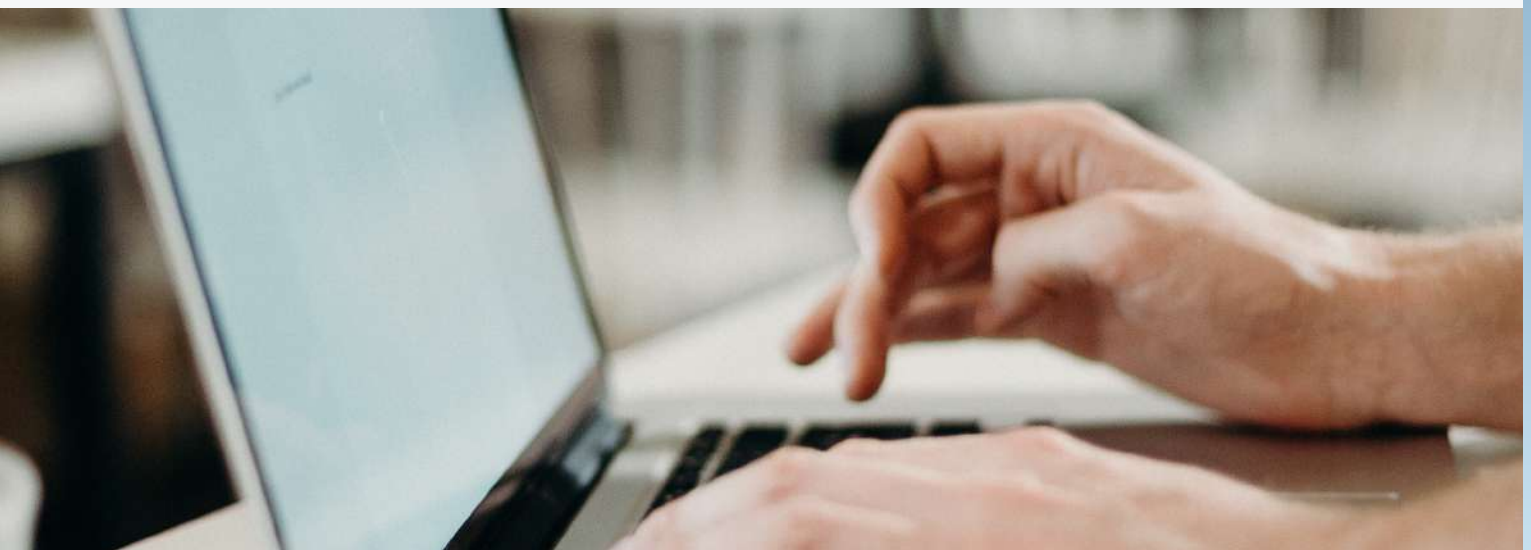
